BECAUSE IT WORKS. UC Davis has done extensive research, and found that the principles of companion planting do, in fact work.

Now, on to how it works. The following table, though not "exhaustive" will give a good idea of which plants like/dislike each other.

| Plant | Likes | Dislikes |

| Beans/Legumes | Cucumber, Strawberry and <br> Potato | Onions/Garlic |
| Beets | Cole Crops |  |
| Broccoli | Sage, Beet, Onion | Tomato, Pole Bean, <br> Strawberry |
| Cabbage Family | Dill, Sage, Peppermint | Tomato, Pole Bean, <br> Strawberry |
| Carrot | Rosemary, Sage |  |
| Collard | Tomato | Tomato |
| Corn | Cucumber, Pumpkin, | Squash, Bean, Potato |

| Melons | Corn, Sunflower | Potato |
| Okra | Sweet bell peppers, <br> Eggplant |  |
| Onion | Cabbage Family, Beet, <br> Strawberry, Tomato. Lettuce | Legumes, all varieties |
| Pea | Radish, Turnip, Carrot, <br> Corn, Cucumber, Bean, | Onion, Garlic |
| Potato | Potato |  |
| Pepper, Sweet | Bean, Corn, Cabbage <br> Family | Pumpkin, Tomato |
| Pepper, Hot | Basil, Okra |  |
| Squash | See Tomato |  |
